Each day we remember God is right beside us throughout our journeys. Seek the Son Ministries Inc. is launching into a property search for a year round camp/retreat center. This retreat facility will accommodate persons with disabilities to enjoy a wide range of recreational activities. We strive to emphasize the ability in disability. This project will also include the building of a disability training center. This center will provide educational programs to help people to create a culture of acceptance in respect to disabilities'.

Currently, we are looking at Camp Wapanacki located in the Northeast Kingdom of Vermont. It formerly was a camp for the blind for 50+ years. The Girl Scouts obtained the property in 1992 and now are looking at divesting this property. We signed a letter of intent, but at the printing of this newsletter, we have not signed a purchase agreement. We will keep you posted on the progress.

Another important project relates to creating a Bible study which will guide people with disabilities to understand their identity in Christ. We want to help people see their identity in respect to God and not their disability. We want to thank Diane Toms for her hard work in developing this study. The board hopes to work through this Bible study in the next six months.

"Sawubona" is the name of a virtual community which will consist of participants for Theresa's doctorate study at Bethel Seminary. This study will have 5-20 participants and its main goal is to research why church attendance and participation is low for the disabled.
