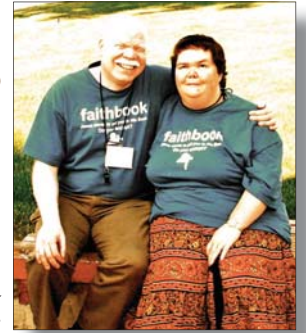
Craft Day
